People in the construction industry continue speaking out against Bill 80. That's legislation which would change the landscape by, the industry says, allowing companies to choose the union on the job site. Terry Parker, with the Saskatchewan Trades Council, calls it a bad bill.

Terry Parker:

We feel that this will start to destabilize the construction industry in Saskatchewan, which has had 17 years of labour civility in the province, and it'll start to lead to lower wages and conditions in the construction industry.
