People in the construction industry unhappy with Bill 80 held a protest outside Sask Party MLA Bill Hutchinson's office. They want to have a meeting with Labour Minister Rob Norris, saying the bill would allow companies, not workers, to choose job site unions. Terry Parker, with the Building Trades Council, says the goal is quite simple.

Terry Parker:

We hope that the government will reconsider Bill 80 and sit down and work with the building trades to find solutions to help improve the construction industry in this province, not tear it down.
